This year's National Gold Star Legacy Run concluded on Thursday August 25 in Oak Grove WI, a suburb of Milwaukee. 5 members from ALR Post 82 safely completed the Run with over 250 other ALR members from all over the US and even some from outside of the US. We rode 2568 miles roundtrip in 8 days through 10 states. This year's ride raised an all-time high of 1.324 million dollars with MD ALR donating \$141K! Maryland was the second highest contributor to the total!

September 17th, 8 Riders participated in a Memorial Ride for James (JB) Burrows MD Gold Star Legacy Run Chaplain who passed away in late 2021. We enjoyed the 45-mile ride as well as a great lunch put on by Post 259. We miss you JB.
