S.A.L. Monthly Meetings are held the First Tuesday of Each Month at 1800hrs



The holiday season is here. I hope everyone had a happy Thanksgiving.

On Saturday, October 28, Kevin and Cathy Bryant, Gary and Pam Shupe, Lennie and Alana Lentz, and I attended the S.A.L. Southern Maryland Region (SMR) Drawdown at Laurel Post 60. The Drawdown is one of the two major annual fundraisers for the SMR. It was a wonderful day for the La Plata Veterans Day parade on November 5. It was good to see so many parade watchers turn out to honor our Veterans. The Post 82 family was well represented. Thanks to Troy Greathouse for once again carrying the Squadron flag.



At the Squadron meeting on November 7, the members voted to donate \$600 for the SMR bingos held at the Charlotte Hall Veterans Home (CHVH) on the 3rd Monday of each month. In addition, the members voted to donate \$500 to Toys for Tots of Charles County, \$100 to the Children's Organ Transplant Association, \$1,000 to the Children's Miracle Network (CMN), \$1,000 to the Child Welfare Foundation (CWF), and \$1,000 to the Casey Cares Foundation. Additional changes to the Squadron 82 Veterans Memorial Scholarship for the coming year were also discussed.

Members of the Squadron were among the large audience to attend the Post's Veterans Day Program on November 11. The video included in this year's program was particularly moving.

On November 12, Gary Shupe and I attended the SMR Fall Meeting at Brandywine Post 227. The Squadron's check for the CHVH bingos was presented. SMR 2nd Vice Commander Buddy Mastin gave his report on the results of the Drawdown. Over \$10,000 was raised. Buddy made a motion, which passed, to donate \$6,000 of the profits to Detachment Commander Joe Lohman's Project, the American Legion SMR Youth Camp in Cheltenham.

Thanks to Gary Shupe, Gale Willett, Alana Lentz, David Quade, Roy Yanosh, Carol Karpiak, Cindy Moruzzi, and Lennie Lentz for their help at the baby back rib dinner on November 17. The next baby back rib dinner will be on December 15.

Gary Shupe and I attended the S.A.L. Detachment of Maryland Executive Committeemen (DEC) meeting at Gold Star Post 191 in Mt. Airy on November 18. Following each committee report, donations were presented. The Squadron's \$1,000 donations to the CMN, CWF, and Casey Cares Foundation were among the \$24,910 in donations presented.

On November 20, Gale Willett and Gary Shupe the Southern Maryland Region bingo at the Charlotte Hall Veterans Home. Two hundred dollars in prizes were handed out to the residents.

Your 2023 membership card is good until December 31, 2023. If you do not renew by December 31, you will be delinquent. I am sure most of us are too old to be delinquent, so make sure to get your dues in before January 1. Dues are still just \$20 for members 21 or over and \$15 for dual members and those under 21.
