Thirty units of blood were collected at the Squadron sponsored American Red Cross Blood Drive held at the Post on March 28. Thanks to 1st Vice Commander Gale Willett and Adjutant Gary Shupe for taking care of the registration and refreshment tables. The next Blood Drive will be held on May 23.

At the Squadron's April 5 meeting the Squadron voted to donate \$800 to Post 82 American Legion baseball teams. I say teams because there are five; one senior team, three junior teams, and one sandlot team. We also voted to donate \$350 to American Legion Boys State, \$1,000 to S.A.L. Detachment of Maryland Commander Mark Fayer's project, the Casey Cares Foundation, \$1,000 to American Legion Riders of Maryland Gold Star Legacy Scholarship Run, \$600 for S.A.L. Southern Maryland Region Charlotte Hall Veterans Home (CHVH) bingos, and \$800 to the National Support Fund in support of Donald "J.R." Hall's run for S.A.L. National Commander, J.R. is currently the second leading candidate, which means he should be installed as National Commander at the National Convention in August 2023. J.R. will be the 7th National Commander from the state of Maryland.

The Squadron hosted a fish fry on April 15. We served 202 dinners. Twelve residents and two staff members from CHVH were quests of the

Post 82 family. Only 14 residents attended but once again, we handed out \$200 in prizes, and everyone had a great time.


## American Legion Riders ALR Meetings are held the Second Thursday of Each Month at 1800hrs
